The NCEMSF Mission

NCEMSF is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization committed to scholarship, research and to creating safer, healthier environments on college and university campuses through the support, promotion, and advocacy of campus-based emergency medical services. In addition to providing for the acquisition of medical knowledge, campus-based EMS allows student participants to develop life skills including leadership, communication, and decision-making. NCEMSF creates an environment where ideas can be exchanged and problems solved.

NCEMSF History

In the early 1990s, with the widespread use of computers linked via the precursor to the Internet, e-mail communication among campus emergency responders was commonplace. For readers of the emergency services Usenet group and its related e-mail list, there was occasionally a thread about campus-related EMS. But frequently, discussions on the topic of campus EMS were shunned as inappropriate or obscure. As a result, the campus EMS groups that existed were isolated; there was no good forum in which they could openly communicate with one another.

In 1993, in response to this need for information exchange, the National Collegiate EMS Foundation was established. Filling a niche, NCEMSF quickly grew. In April 1994, NCEMSF held its first conference at Georgetown University. Representatives from over twenty campus EMS organizations spent the weekend learning about EMS and networking with each other. Annual conferences have since become the centerpiece of campus EMS interaction and the cornerstone of the Foundation. Providing networking and information exchange among campus emergency responders remains NCEMSF's top goal.
